Recital 2018 Dress Rehearsal Schedule At Wallkill High School

All dancers must be dressed (with hair & makeup), warmed up and ready to dance 1/2 hour before their posted rehearsal time. We cannot wait for late comers (you are considered late if you're not ready 1/2 hour before your posted time as we may be running ahead of schedule & we will go on.) We cannot let dancers perform if they do not rehearse onstage. If we start & your child is not there we will immediately begin replacing them in the dance. You should also prepare to be finished rehearsing up to an hour early or an hour late. Parents, please take this into consideration when making pick up plans for your child at the end of the day. If we have to pay overtime fees to custodians and stage crew because of kids not being picked up on time we will pass those fees on to you.

For Dress Rehearsal all students, who only have 1 dance in the show (no costume changes) should come to the theatre already dressed in their costume and proceed to wait quietly in the audience until they are called to the stage. No one in this group is allowed to go into the long hallway, backstage or into the dressing rooms for rehearsal. If you can't get your child ready before you come, then you may use the lobby restroom (which can be used by the dancers in rehearsals only ~ not at the performances).

Older kids (in more than one dance) should come dressed in their first costume and then changes in the front dressing room at rehearsal - but you must change quickly. You must hurry to the audience to await being called onto stage. No one should line up in the hall (as we do at performances) until you have been told to do so from Miss Lisa or Peter. You're not going to hear this call unless you are sitting quietly in the audience. We will not come looking for you in the hallway, lobby or dressing room. Parents may assist their child quickly in the dressing room and then go into the auditorium with them to wait. Neither parents nor students should loiter in the dressing room at any time.

Cameras/Phones are not allowed in the audience at rehearsal or performances. Cell phones must be turned off and not used inside the auditorium. Anyone in violation will be asked to leave. We do not have sympathy for people who refuse to follow our guidelines or feel that the rules apply to everyone but them. This is not fair to all those who cooperate with our requests. If you need another copy of this paper to give to another person who may be bringing your child (so they will also be aware of procedure) we will be happy to provide you with one.

You may take pictures (and use your phone) in the Lobby or outside the theatre. Not in the Dressing Rooms or the Long Hall that leads up to the dressing rooms. There will be a professional photographer at the Dress Rehearsal who does a great job of photographing the children. There will be a videographer at the performance who does a great job of capturing the whole show (which your child will enjoy watching for years!)

Dress Rehearsal:

Children will be released to their parents (who are waiting in the audience) after they dance (and bow) at the end of their time slots for dress rehearsal. Rehearsing is not an exact science and these rehearsal times only serve as a loose guideline. If we're running early we will go ahead of the posted times by as much as half an hour. If we're running late – you can be assured we are working as hard as we can to stay on time but, be positive so you and your child (and everyone within earshot) can have a wonderful positive recital weekend!

All dancers in Act 1 must be signed in by 2:30 PM.

All dancers in Act 2 & Act 3 must sign in at the beginning of the intermission before they perform. During Performance children will not be released to parents until the end of their Act (not dance but whole Act ~ at the intermission).
